

HMS AP Process vs. Council Process

HMS Advisory Panel	Regional Councils
AP recommendations <i>advisory</i> in nature	Council members <i>vote</i> to approve/disapprove actions to submit to NMFS
NMFS decides what actions to consider and implement	NMFS approves or disapproves action
HMS staff seek input of Science Center staff and other experts	Scientific & Statistical Committees provide expert advice to Council
AP meets approximately 2x/year	Councils meet approximately 5x/year
Anyone can nominate themselves to be considered for the HMS Advisory Panel	Council member nominations must be submitted by state or territory governors








The IPT is a group of experts from diverse fields for every amendment.








Rulemaking is the process step after Council final action and before implementation.






Rulemaking





Rulemaking refers to the process that agencies use to create regulations.







Rulemaking refers to the process that agencies must use to create regulations.

Secretary of Commerce Review



Approves, disapproves, or partially approves <u>amendment</u>



Determine whether <u>plan</u> & <u>regulations</u> consistent with fishery management plan, MSA, and other applicable law


